Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you for continuing to follow our school covid measures. Although the announcement that measures are soon to be relaxed, things are not going as swimmingly as they have been for St John Bosco. We have had to close one bubble and we have a number of staff and children self isolating due to contact with positive cases outside school.
