

Parent update Tuesday 21st December 2021

Dear Parents and Carers,

Happy New Year! I hope you have all had a peaceful time over the Christmas holidays. It has been wonderful to start 2022 in school and be together again.

There are various items of news to update you on:

Pay 360 / Sims Pay - Payments for school dinners, afterschool and breakfast club need to be made in advance. Failure to pay for these services may lead to places being withdrawn. If you intend to swap your child from school dinners to packed lunches please phone the school office to let us know in advance.

School uniform – please see our policy here. Again, may I remind you all that the children are to wear shoes, not boots or trainers and that earrings are to be plain studs only.

Post Christmas Overwhelm – if you feel you have too much in your house or are having an early Spring Clean, we would be grateful for donations of children's dressing up clothes.

Afterschool Activities - We are planning to start up some afterschool activity clubs. These will be free of charge and will run for this half term, we will then swap year groups after the February break. Children must be collected by an adult aged 16 or above at 4pm.
