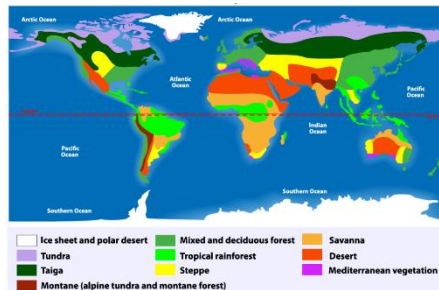

- Know Europe has 44 countries, while North America contains 23 and South America has 12.
- Know each continent features significant capital cities that serve as political and cultural centres.
- Know a biome is a large area characterised by specific climate conditions and ecosystems, including types like tundra, deserts, and tropical forests.
- Know North and South America share some biomes, whereas Europe has distinct geographical features like the Alps.
- Know the continents are home to various languages, with diverse populations: approximately 747 million in Europe, 367 million in North America, and 428 million in South America.
