

Parent update Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> August

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you and your families are enjoying the holidays and have been making the most of the lovely weather (until today)! We've only two weeks left until the children are back in school - we are really looking forward to seeing everyone!

### **Classroom Drop-In Y1-6**

We are aware that you send your children in to us every day and that you can't always visualise where they sit, where they put their coats etc. We would like to invite you to come and have a quick look at your children's classroom as follows:

Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> September - Parents of Y1, Y4 and Y6, please collect your children from inside their classrooms. All other children to be collected from their usual exits.

Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> September - Parents of Y2, Y3 and Y5, please collect your children from inside their classrooms. All other children to be collected from their usual exits.

Please note - these classroom drop-ins are non-essential, if you can't make it, that is fine.

Nursery and Reception parents, we haven't extended this invitation to you, as you drop your children at their classroom doors each day.

### **Reminders**

Year 6 children must continue to be dropped off and collected at hometime by an adult aged 16 or above. Once the children have settled into year 6 we will send out our walking home from school policy and agreement for you to sign.

Please don't buy bags, pencil cases or water bottles for your children. Children are allowed to bring their lunchboxes to school (which are kept downstairs) and a flat reading folder. These are available to buy from the school office once school is reopened. We provide water bottles which are washed and refilled daily.

Uniform - please see our uniform policy [here](#). In particular, please remember to buy school shoes (not trainers with a sports logo or boots). Some children wear these as they have a diagnosed medical need. If you see someone else's child in trainers, this could be the reason why. Also, please remember that earrings must be plain round studs and that hair colour and/or braids should be a natural colour only.

School and the school office reopen on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> September. Breakfast club opens at 8am, other children are to arrive between 8.45 and 8.55am.
